Strategic Highlights

For our Shanghai Sunrise students, sponsors, volunteers and our community, 2022 was a year of many challenges. The lockdowns in the first half of the year saw many cherished Shanghai Sunrise volunteers and sponsors leaving Shanghai and has seen an increase in families in difficulty. The fore-mentioned, together with the additional stress of food uncertainty and online learning, added to the pressure of the Grade 12's 2023 GaoKao (university entrance) exams. Giving back to community and empowering fortunate youth with education and personal development opportunities was of utmost importance.

Financial Highlights

Despite the challenges, in 2022 Shanghai Sunrise raised close to 2.3 million RMB. The organization assisted 327 students continuing their high school and university education and held one very special studentsponsor event in late 2022. Our first ever "online" pairing ceremony for newly paired and students provided sponsors important opportunity for students, sponsors and volunteers to connect and have fun.

Operating Highlights

There have been several changes to the Board of Directors. Helen Yang resigned as she repatriated to the USA in early 2023. We thank her for her commitment and invaluable contributions made during her tenure. We would also like to wish her all the best with her future endeavors. Highlights



Christmas Market

Shanghai Sunrise hosted a table at the Shanghai Expats Association (SEA) Christmas market at the Pullman Hotel on 14 November 2022, and participated in the Paulaner Christmas Market at the end of December 2022. Shanghai Sunrise volunteers teamed up with two Shanghai Sunrise-sponsored art students. They created unique gifts such as coasters, puzzles and cushions, which were sold at the markets.





Due to the pandemic, we had to brush up on our technical skills and conduct the 2022/2023 pairing ceremony online. Thinking out-of-the-box, volunteers created nine different groups to introduce new students and sponsors to one another. They had fun chatting and playing games.

We had 42 sponsors and 103 students join the online pairing ceremony. Once again, we are beyond grateful for everyone's generosity. Shanghai Sunrise has 18 new individuals, who are sponsoring 20 students. In addition, corporate sponsors Henkel and Goodman Group have each added 10 students to their sponsorship programs.

Two Christmas workshops were held in December 2022 as part of the Shanghai Sunrise online Chat initiative. The workshops are English designed to help students improve their English listening, reading and speaking skills while also familiarizing them with some aspects of Western culture. Ten students joined the workshops. They all enjoyed learning about various Christmas traditions and customs. Students asked many questions and some shared their own Christmas experiences.




Shanghai Sunrise & Goodman initiatives

Webinar: Dealing with anxiety in uncertain times



During the Shanghai lockdown our sponsor, Goodman Group, a leading real estate company, hosted an online webinar on "Dealing with Anxiety in Uncertain Times". It was led by external speaker Adina Deacu. The webinar was popular among the students and extremely timely. It helped empower students to better manage their psychological wellbeing and gain an understanding of how environmental elements can influence their mental state. Thirty-two students joined the webinar.





Reading program: The Happiness Advantage

This five-part guided reading program offered students a chance to rewire their thoughts positively. The central idea is to draw a connection between personal happiness and personal success. Working through The **Happiness** Advantage book offered students a chance to interact and practise their English listening and speaking skills with other students. Sixteen students participated in the five-week long program.

Sponsor Collaboration: Career Day

To provide students with career advice and a professional development opportunity, Shanghai Sunrise collaborated with our sponsors, Goodman Group, a leading real estate company and Hays, a company that specialised in recruiting talent worldwide, in hosting a Career Day event.

Do Good, Be Good Tech Scholarship



The Goodman Group launched their Do Good, Be Good Tech Scholarship towards the end of 2022. Applications were open to all Shanghai Sunrise students. Students were encouraged explain how having a new laptop would alleviate some of the challenges they are facing with their studies.

A highlight of Career Day was announcing the recipients of the Do Good. Be Good Tech Scholarship and awarding 20 students with new laptops.




Financials 2022


